Love addicts assign too much time, attention, and value to another person while neglecting themselves. Love avoidants use walls instead of being relational in order to prevent feeling overwhelmed in relationships. Participants will learn how we are set up for both, as well as a greater awareness of how these cycles can show up in adult relationships.



SUSAN LESSLEY (MA) is a Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist, working with individuals, couples, groups, and families. She has been in private practice since 2008. Her focus areas include Post Induction Therapy (PIT, trained by Pia Mellody), eye movement desensitization and reprocessing (EMDR), trauma resiliency model (TRM), and Family of Origin Trauma workshops. Susan also has experience treating sexual addiction and sexual offenders.
